Grade Policies

Students must earn a C or better in all required and elective courses in the AT Program. If you fail to earn a grade of C or higher in this course, you will be required to retake the class during the next term when it is offered. You will not be allowed to continue in the AT Professional Program course sequence until you earn a C or higher in each course.

Retention Requirements

Students admitted to the Professional Program must meet the following criteria for retention:

- earn a grade of C or higher in all AT professional courses and supporting classes
- maintain a cumulative or overall GPA of 2.5
- uphold The University of Alabama Code of Student Conduct and the NATA Code of Ethics
- meet all clinical clearance deadlines (through CastleBranch)
- continue to meet the technical standards for the program
- follow all AT Program policies and procedures
- comply with all clinical education site-specific policies and procedures during assignment to the corresponding clinical site
- participate in AT Program-specific academic advising
- show commitment to the AT Program through demonstration of academic, organizational and financial ability to participate in all program requirements
